SUBJECT SHOWCASES

To enhance parental/carer engagement, and to give an insight into different subjects, we will be holding 'Subject Showcase' events. There will be two sessions, a morning and an afternoon. Please only attend one as they will be showcasing the same subject. Please do not all head to the same year group, and if one classroom looks busy please make your way to an alternative year group.

What will this look like? Each class will be teaching the same subject and you can visit all classes to see what it looks like in each year group. This will show how skills develop and children progress throughout their time at Upwell. As these will be taught lessons, there will not be an opportunity for discussion with staff or children. However, Mrs Norman will be available in the hall with test papers (if appropriate) and willing to answer questions. The test papers and other resources will show what is expected of a child in each particular year group. We hope that by showcasing the subjects in this way it will give you a better understanding of what is expected of children in each year group, and the high expectations we have for them.

The focus of the first Subject Showcase will be reading (this could be decoding, comprehension, retrieval, inference or deduction) because of the importance of learning to read and reading to learn, and the impact this has on all other subjects.
