

The French Revolution - History Y5

Before the French Revolution...

French society was divided into 3 groups ('estates')

- 1. Clergy (religious figures of the Catholic Church)
- 2. **Nobles** (aristocracy people born into wealthy, important families)
- 3. The rest workers, **peasants**, doctors and lawyers, etc.

The King was not part of the estates as he was deemed too important and powerful!



Revolution - a time when people overthrow the power of those ruling and try to change how people live and work.

Absolute Monarchy - when a King or Queen is in complete control and doesn't need to follow any rules or laws.

The Bastille - a prison in Paris, used by the French Kings.





Crowned King of France in 1744 (an absolute monarch, beheaded in 1793)

Became Queen of France when her husband became King (beheaded in 1793)

Hugely successful military leader who became emperor of France (died in exile on the island of St Helena)

British admiral in the Royal Navy who defeated Napoleon at the Battle of Trafalgar, preventing an invasion.

British army general who defeated Napoleon at the Battle of Waterloo.
