
The Rise of Hitler and WW2 —History Year 6



The Treaty of Versailles—A document signed in 1919 to officially end WW1. Outlining punishments enforced upon Germany 'Germany had to take the B.L.A.M.E.'



Kristallnacht 9th/10th November 1938 — Nazis in Germany torched synagogues, vandalized Jewish homes, schools and businesses, and murdered close to 100 Jews. In the aftermath of Kristallnacht, some 30,000 Jewish men were arrested and sent to Nazi concentration camps. <u>History.com</u>

World War 2 — On September 1, 1939, Hitler invaded Poland from the west; two days later, France and Britain declared war on Germany, beginning World War II.





Adolf Hitler

The leader of the Nazi Party from 1933 to 1945.

Winston Churchill

The Prime Minister of Great Britain from 1940 to 1945. Hitler Youth — set up by Adolf Hitler in 1933 for educating and training male youth in Nazi principles.
