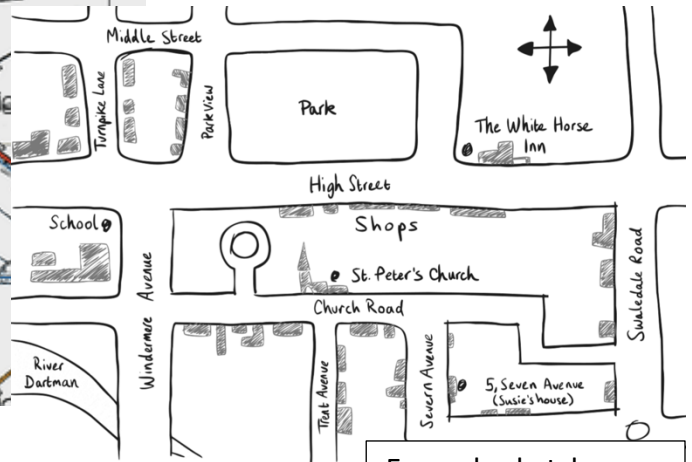
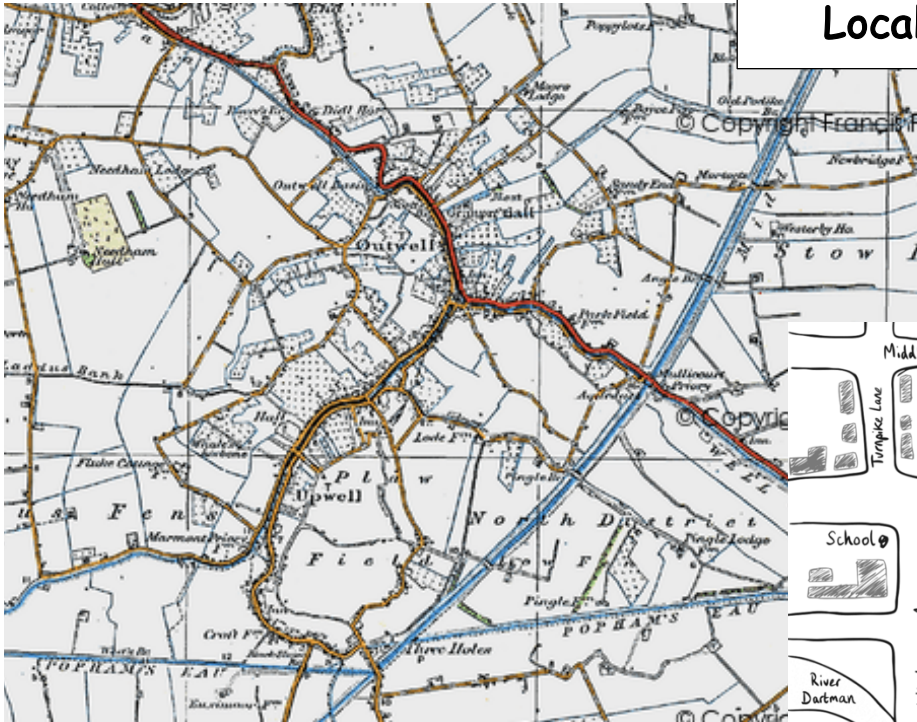


Local Study - Geography Y5

Ordnance Survey map	Ordnance survey maps are up to date and accurate maps depicting the landscape's human and physical features. All OS maps use the same symbols, which are included in a key so people using the map know what each symbol represents.
Sketch map	A simple, hand drawn map, from sight or memory, showing the key human and physical features in an area.
Graph	A mathematical drawing that shows information using lines, shapes and colours.
Analyse	To look closely at something and understand it.
Data	Information, often facts or numbers, then can be collected and analysed to help us understand something.
Fieldwork	The process of observing and collecting data about people, cultures and natural environments.
Local councillor	A person elected to a local council to represent the views of the local residents.
Resident	Someone who lives in a particular place.
