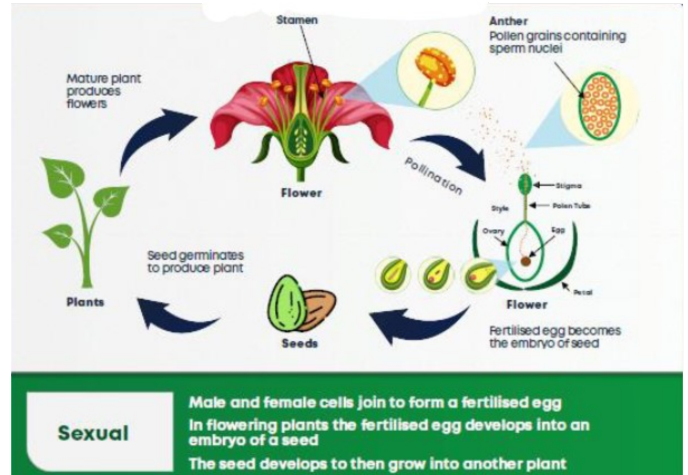
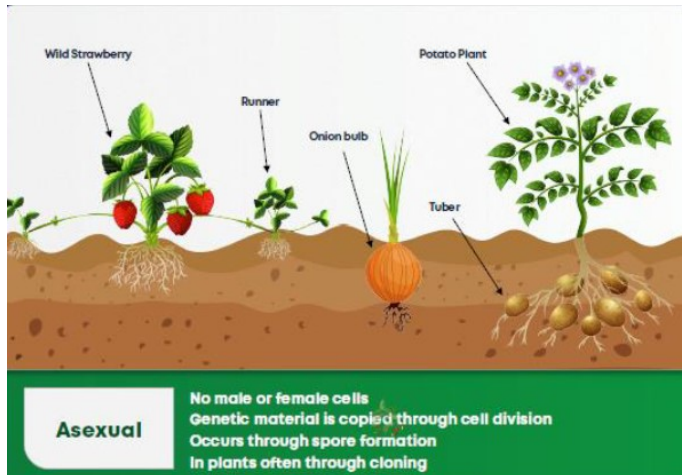


Reproduction — Science Year 6

Reproduction— the process of copying or making a copy, in animals reproduction creates offspring.



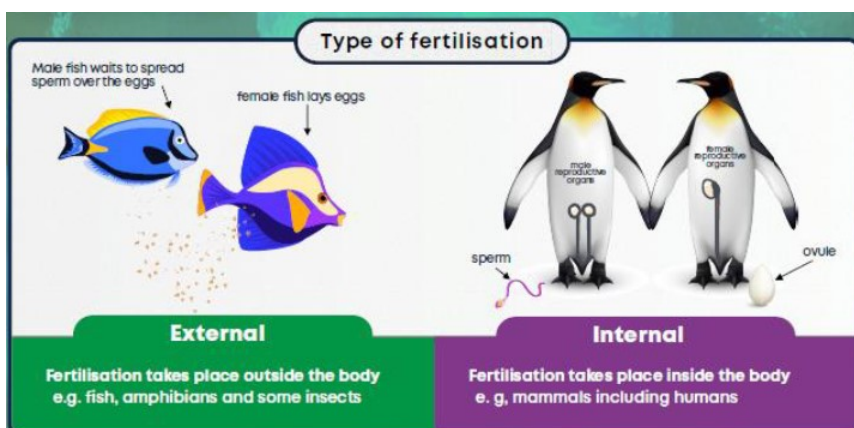
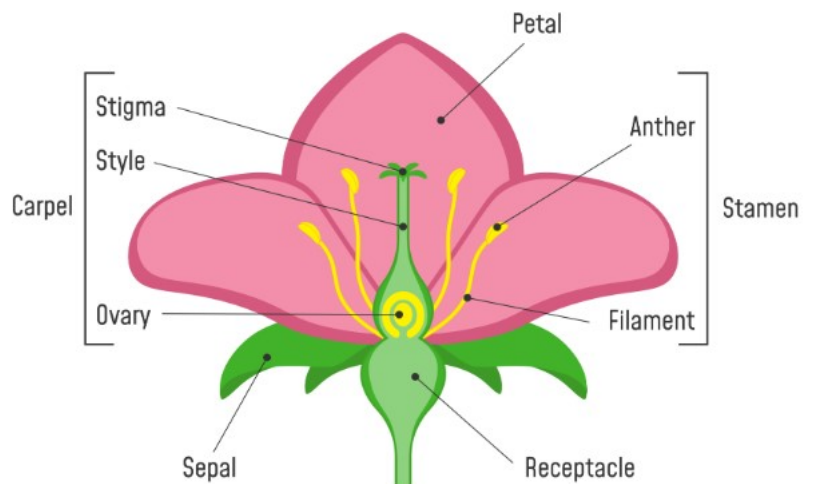
Asexual reproduction—a form of reproduction where offspring comes from one living organism.

Sexual reproduction—a form of reproduction where offspring comes from two living organisms; producing new organisms by combining genetic information from male and female cells.

Germinate—the stage where a living organism starts to sprout, grow and develop..

Pollination—the process when pollen moves from the male part of the flower (anther) to the female part of the flower (stigma).

Fertilisation—Male and female gametes join to make a new organisms.



Foetus—an unborn offspring

Gestation—the period of development before birth
