Learning Highlights of the Week

Reception: Enchanted Forest Class

This week Year R have been practising phoning the emergency services. They used real phones and loved asking for the service and explaining the situation. We have been revising all of the sounds we have learnt so far and we continue to subitize and we started looking at more and fewer in a set.

Year 1: Crunchem Hall Class

This week in Maths, Year 1 have been comparing different measures. We have looked at length, height, weight and volume. We particularly enjoyed using balance scales to determine which objects were heavier or lighter.

Year 2: Neverland Class

This week, Year 2 have shown a fantastic understanding of addition and subtraction. We have been adding and subtracting 2digit numbers with ones and other 2digit numbers. We have then successfully applied our learning to solve a range of shape, word and reasoning problems.

Year 3: Narnia Class

We have had a busy week completing their first set of assessments. They have all tried exceptionally hard and maintained excellent focus throughout the week. In maths, Year 3 have enjoyed practicing column addition and subtraction (without making exchanges). In English, Year 3 have written their own set of instructions on 'How to wash a woolly mammoth.'

Year 4: Wonderland Class

In maths we have been looking at different types of problems and how we can solve them. We have looked at word problems and logic problems. The logic problems really made us think — especially the sudoku! Miss Radford did go on a bit about making sure we read the question and that we checked our answers - because she knows we don't always do this!

Year 5: Shire Class

This week we have been looking at factors in maths and doing lots of multiplication. The children have impressed me lots and improved greatly throughout the week. We also started looking at Treasure Island in our English and have had a great time discussing different characters and possibilities. Well done Year 5 you have had a great half term. Enjoy your break!

Year 6: Hogwarts Class

We have an excellent week. In PSHE we've learnt to recognise how images in the media, including online do not always reflect reality, and can affect how people feel about themselves and in Science we enjoyed carrying out an investigation about how exercise affects pulse rate which Miss Ellington enjoyed observing!


