Ever wondered what it was like for Tim Peake? How do you get into space, and what is it like to live and work there?



A shout out and thank you to Mr Best who kindly loaned us equipment needed for the day.







# **Learning Highlights of the Week**

## **Reception: Enchanted Forest Class**

A fantastic first week back, we have been consolidating all of our set 1 and 2 sounds. We loved science day and learnt about the lifecycle of a human as well as how we might get to space in a special assembly. We also had our last dance session with our dance coach Macy.

#### **Year 1: Crunchem Hall Class**

We have been learning the story of The Gingerbread Man this week! On Monday we think a fox stole Mrs Kirk's biscuit, we created 'wanted' posters and luckily, he did bring another biscuit back to school. We have been developing our story telling by using a story map and

acting it out with puppets. We also took part in drama activities to explore the thoughts and feelings of the characters.

## **Year 2: Neverland Class**

In English, we have been consolidating the use of contractions and apostrophes and we all have a really good understanding now. In Mathematics we have enjoyed continuing our work on measures in maths, specifically exploring weight. We have had our final dance session ready for next weeks' Festival but will have an opportunity to run through again early next week.

#### **Year 3: Narnia Class**

We have had great fun with poetry this week, writing Limericks, Haiku and Concrete poems. I have also been very impressed with how well the children are doing in our new maths topic of fractions. Finally, we carried out an investigation into friction in science and everyone worked very hard to produce excellent experimental write ups!

#### **Year 4: Wonderland Class**

We have been learning about Richard III in English and history. We had a long debate about what we think happened to the Princes in the Tower. Most of us decided that Richard has something to do with their disappearance. We found it interesting that nobody knows the truth.

#### **Year 5: Shire Class**


